The course could use a few more drops of rain but overall continues to be in terrific condition, thanks to our hard working grounds staff. Saulte!

By the time you are reading this, green aerification will be healed and a distant memory. We contracted a new machine called the "dryject" to do the job quicker and ensure we get sand in the holes. We had a few machine breakdowns from the contractor, but we achieved the goals of sand in the holes and healthier greens.

You may have noticed some ponds are low with the dry weather. The lower ponds on holes 1, 9, 10, 18 and 27 are fed by industrial park runoff. When we expect a big rain we open our dam to reduce flooding. A big rain was forecasted so we lowered the ponds. But the rains missed us so the ponds will remain low until we get a normal rain.

The irrigation pond by holes 8, 11, 12 and 17 is low due to extra watering with the dry windy conditions this month. Our well can supplement the pond, but rains are needed to keep it full during times of high evapotranspiration.
